Technology – use technology purposefully to create, organise, store, manipulate and retrieve digital content

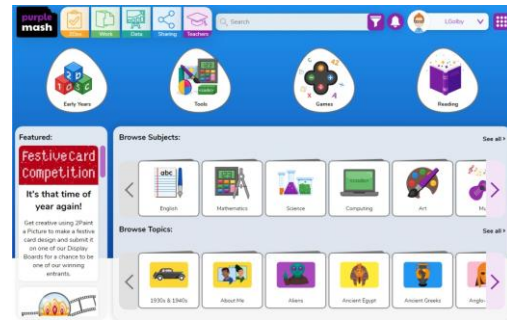
Key Vocabulary

Work area	Where you save your work online.

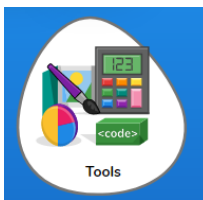

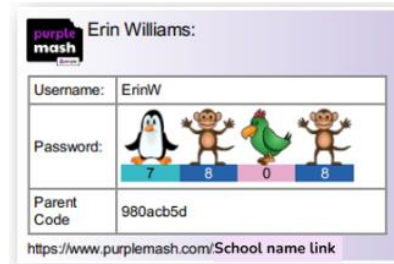
