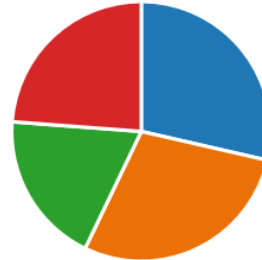

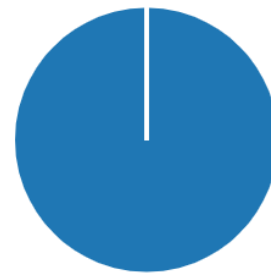

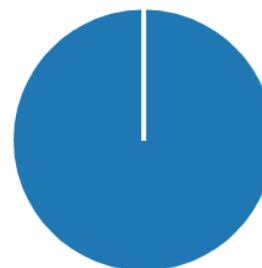
2. How well have we kept you informed of Covid procedures this academic year to date?

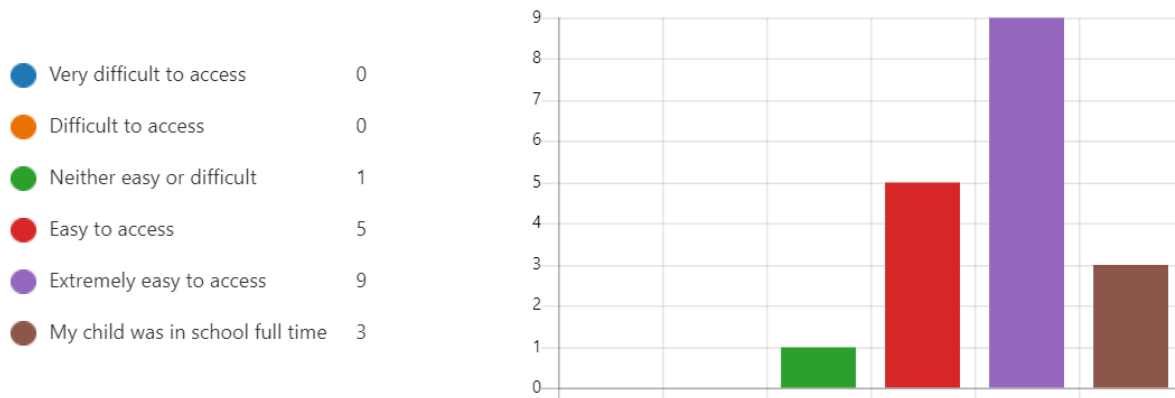


4. During the partial school closure, my child was in school ...

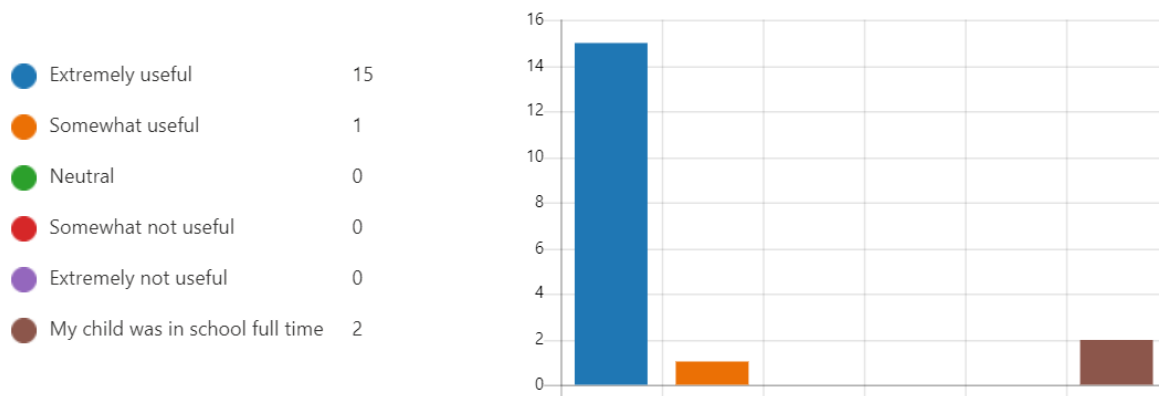

7. What did we do well in terms of home learning? What worked well for you?

Flexibility of when to complete the school work as most was uploaded several days prior to the lesson date, enabling us to complete it in small chunks at weekends and before/after work.
Very clear recordings of tasks- they were enthusiastic and just what we needed.
The video for phonics, maths and literacy provided by Mrs. Wooldridge were excellent. Entertaining, interactive and well recorded. My child loved it.

Videos each day helped my child concentrate
Loved the video for each topic so they could work more independently . Keeping the school day as normal as possible with subjects each day. Routine was very helpful. Feedback great.
Like all families, it wasn't always easy. Our biggest issue because how many videos we had to watch as that coupled with the work really was very time consuming. This was quite hard due to various home distractions and other children at home who had different needs. We found it particularly stressful after the half-term but this wasn't purely down to the work but rather tangled with various frustrations with lockdown/Groundhog Day.
It was amazing! All staff worked EXTREMELY hard to ensure our children were well supported. The videos were brilliant and children were inspired to complete their learning at home and enjoyed it. Work was well differentiated and offered appropriate challenge where needed. Feedback was useful and also encouraging to the children- and us parents too to keep going! Teachers were always able to be contacted if necessary and although the children were at home, it didn't feel like they were missing

out at all. Having assemblies and social sessions where children were rewarded and recognised for their efforts also made the transition from school to the home learning process effective. Thank you so much for all of your hard work- an excellent set up that worked so well.
Excellent videos and activities provided that we could access at a time that suited us.
Videos that meant we could complete home learning whenever it was convenient was really helpful. Range of activities was good. We would often complete learning all morning and then complete home activities in the afternoon, which I felt was the right balance for my reception child. Phone calls home were useful and someone was always on hand to answer any questions.
Videos from class teachers were excellent, we could watch them when convenient and pause / restart as needed. My child was convinced class teachers could see her which helped with motivation to complete work! Phone calls home were really useful as if I had a question I knew that there would always be someone who could answer them. Loved the bear delivery!
Videos from teachers were really useful. I liked that everything was ready for 9am and then we could access activities when it was suitable for us. If we found things difficult to complete one day or were finding motivation difficult, we could just catch up the next day.
My child was in school full time but it was good information was sent out so that we could access Teams if needed.
Really good to have daily instructions from Mrs Wooldridge by video to show what we needed to do with the activities each day. Collective worship sessions was a nice touch too, especially the one that we could join with rewards on a Friday which helped keep us motivated some weeks.
The comments from the class teachers helped my daughter as she knew they were looking at her work. Videos to show what we needed to do and phone calls home helped to support us know what to do.
I liked that there was a video and then an activity. The videos meant that we could log in and complete work around our own work commitments. Although we couldn't always make it, I liked the option to join for assembly on a Friday. Individual and phone calls and a session with the teacher were really appreciated. I liked that usernames and passwords were given out well in advance so when the time came, all we had to do was follow the instructions and we could get going without any problems.

8. What could we have improved on in terms of home learning? What didn't work well for you?

Some of the videos were quite long and it was difficult to maintain our child's concentration.
I would have been good to be able to download all the worksheets (maths) so they could be typed on to.
The reward system was not very clear

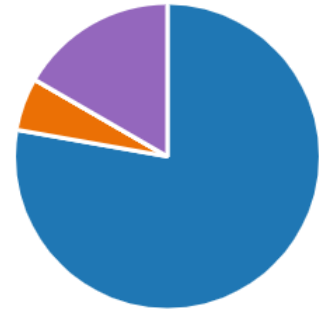
The individual session with the teacher was really useful - could these have been more regular?

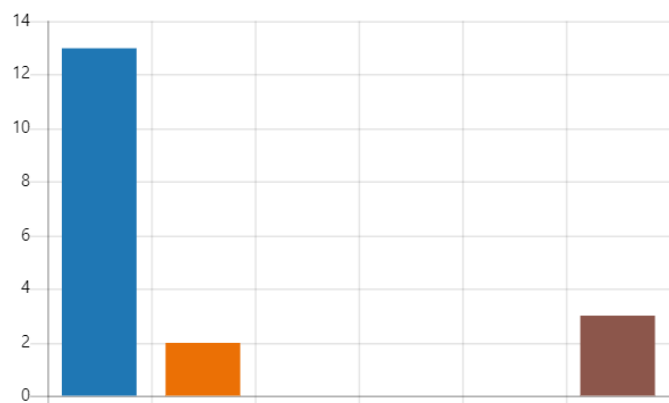
