









Maths – Numbers 0-5

Prior Learning	Concepts
Rote counts to 10. Can subitise to 3.	1:1 Counting – Assign one number name to each item being counted, counting each item only once and ensuring all have been counted.
Understands that objects, pictures and actions can be counted.	Subitising – Instantly recognise a small quantity, without having to count how many there are.

Key Vocabulary

More or Fewer	Comparing quantities to see which group has more or fewer objects.		
Counting	Objects can be counted to find out how many there are altogether.		
Number	A count, a measure or a label		
Numeral	The written symbol of a number		
Subitise	Be able to 'see' quantities without counting.

1) You must say the numbers in the right order when counting.	
2) The last count tells you how many are in the set.	
3) You count each item once.	
4) I can subitise up to 5 items or dots.
