

Maths – Numbers 6-10

Prior Learning

Rote counts to 10.

Can perceptually and conceptually subitise to 5.

Counts actions, sounds and objects accurately to 5.

Concepts

Counting forwards and backwards – saying number names in sequence, either forwards or backwards from any given number, within 10

1 more/1 less – recognising that if they add one, they will get the next number, or if one is taken away, they will have the previous number.

Key Vocabulary

Compare	Identifying the number that is greater than, less than or equal to the other number.
Represent	Use the correct objects, numerals or pictures to show an amount.
Number	A count, a measure or a label
Numeral	The written symbol of a number
Order	Put the numerals in stable order from 1-10
