## Prior Learning

Using coins in real life.

Understand coins and note values

## Concepts

**Amounts of money** – counting and using money to solve problems  
**Coins** – the actual coin amounts, bronze and silver coins. Representing £ and p.

**Notes** – paper money representing pounds £

**Finding change**- spending an amount and receiving change

## Key Vocabulary

<b>pound</b>	100 pence +£1
<b>pence</b>	Smallest measure of money
<b>coins</b>	Bronze -1p, 2p, Silver - 5p, 10p, 20p, 50p, £1, £2
<b>amounts</b>	Adding coins together
<b>counting</b>	Counting values of coins in 1p, 2p, 5p, 10p
<b>change</b>	Spending an amount and getting money back
<b>Same amount</b>	Comparing and making same amounts of money using different coins and notes

Money in Britain is Pounds and pence.

There are 100 pence in £1
