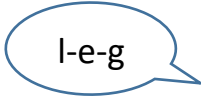
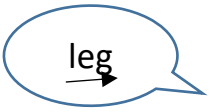
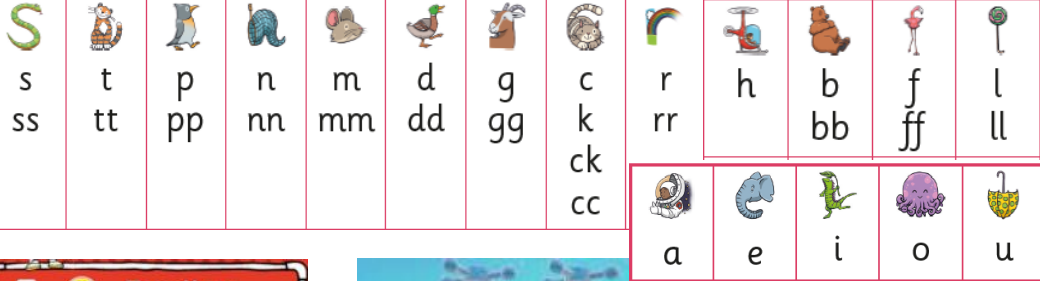


Writing – Phase 2
