# Starting and finishing school

## In the morning...

You can come into the playground from 8:30. The bell rings at 8:45 and you line up in front of your teacher. If you get the school bus, an adult will bring you from the bus to the playground.



## In the afternoon...

You go home at 3:15. You need to get your water bottles, book bag and coat. You walk sensibly through the school and meet your family on the playground. You must wait with Mrs Wooldridge until she says it is safe to go to your family. Some of you might go home on the school bus!

This is where you hang up your coats.



In your classroom, you put your water bottles and book bags into the boxes which show your animal group picture. You are either in the badger, fox, squirrel or rabbit group.



You must bring a coat, water bottle and book bag to school every day.

# School Uniform

At school, children wear a red school cardigan or red jumper, and a white or red polo shirt. Children wear a grey skirt, dress, trousers or shorts. In the summer you could wear a red and white summer dress. You will need to wear black shoes on your feet that you can fasten by yourself.



## P.E. days

On a Wednesday and Friday you will wear your P.E. kits to school. You will wear jogging bottoms, leggings or shorts with your t-shirt, jumper or cardigan. You will wear white or black trainers that you can fasten by yourself.

# Toilets

This is where you will go to the toilet and wash your hands.



# School Lunchtimes

You will eat your lunch in the school hall. You will sit with children from other year groups who will help serve your lunch. When you think you are finished, you will put up your hand and one of the adults will let you know what to do next.





After your lunch you have playtime on the playground. The adults usually get play equipment out of the sheds and arrange games for you to play during the lunchtime playtime. At the end of playtime, the bell will ring and you will line up to go back into your classroom.

You can play on the tyres at playtime and lunchtime unless it is wet and slippery.

Mrs O'Reilly is a teaching assistant who helps children with their learning in school.

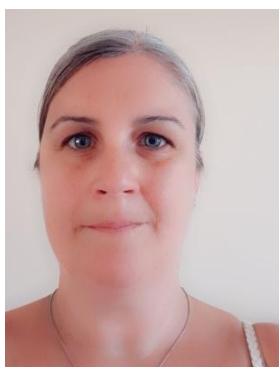

Mrs Everitt is a teacher in school, she teaches the older children in Years 1 and 2.

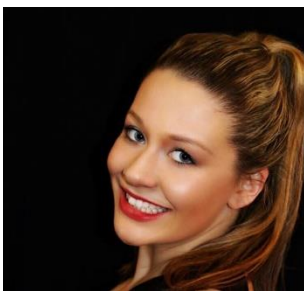
Miss Scofield is a teacher in school, she teaches the older children in Years 1 and 2.
