# Starting and finishing Nursery

## In the morning...

You can come into the playground from 8:30. The bell rings at 8:45 and you line up in front of Mrs Wooldridge who is your teacher and key worker. Mrs Abbott will also help you to line up.



## At home time...

You might go home at the end of the morning, after lunch or at the end of the school day. You will need to get your water bottle, book bag and coat. You meet your family in the main school entrance if you are collected during the day, or on the playground at the end of the school day.

This is where you hang up your coats.



In your classroom, you put your water bottles and book bags into the boxes which show your animal group picture. An adult will help you with this and will show you which group you are in.



You must bring a coat, water bottle and book bag to school every day.

# Uniform

You will need to wear a uniform in Nursery. Children wear a red school cardigan or red jumper, and a white or red polo shirt. Children wear a grey skirt, dress, trousers or shorts. In the summer you could wear a red and white summer dress. You will need to wear black shoes on your feet that you can try to take on and off and fasten by yourself. An adult will help you if you find this a bit tricky. We have wellies that you can borrow, but you might like to have your own pair in school that you can wear in the outside area.



# Toilets

This is where you will go to the toilet and wash your hands.



# Lunchtimes

If you are staying for lunch, you will eat your lunch in the school hall. The teaching assistants will come into the hall with you. They will serve you your lunch and will help you to cut up your food. After you have eaten your lunch, you will have some time to play with your friends.

# School Staff

These are the adults that you will see around school.



This is Mrs Wooldridge. She is your class teacher and key worker and will be at school all day.

This is Mrs Abbott. She will work with you when you are in Nursery. She will also help you at lunchtime.



This is Mr Pettenuzzo (Mr P!). He is a teaching assistant who helps children with their learning.

Mrs Morton is a teaching assistant who helps children with their learning in school.





Mrs O'Reilly is a teaching assistant who helps children with their learning in school. She might also teach your class if your teacher is poorly or on a course.

Mrs Swinburn runs the before and after school clubs – Early Birds and Wise Owls. Children have great fun in these clubs! She also works in the classrooms to help children with their learning in school.



Mrs Gettings is a teaching assistant. She helps children with their learning in school.

Mrs Baxter is our School Business Manager. She is in school every Wednesday. You might see her in the school office or around school.





Mrs Unsworth is a teaching assistant who helps children with their learning.

Mrs Eames works in the school office every day. You might see her if you collect the registers, or she might pop into your classroom.



Mrs Everitt is a teacher in school, she teaches the children in Years 1 and 2.

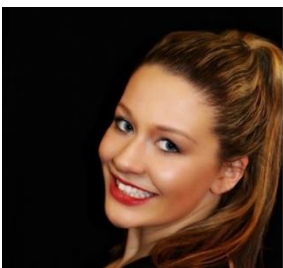
Miss Scofield is a teacher in school, she teaches the children in Years 1 and 2.

We follow instructions.

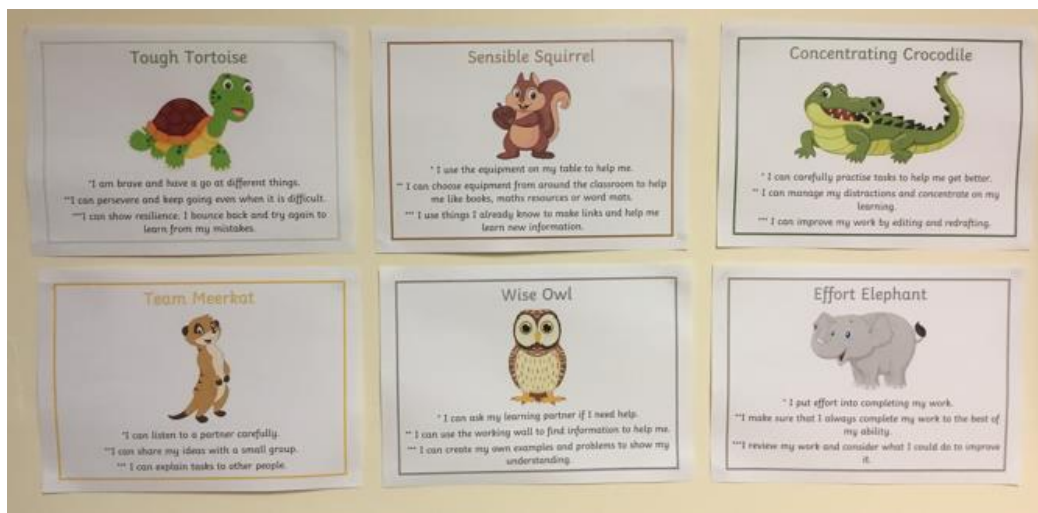
We listen to each other.
