





# Art – Yayoi Kusama

Prior Learning		Concepts	
Begins to use shape to represent objects.		Artist – A person who creates art	
Experiments by mixing paint.		Art – Something that you find beautiful, interesting or amazing. People might say “That painting is a work of art!”	
Uses tools to print and make marks, e.g. paintbrushes, hands, stamps.		Images, icons and maps.	
Key Vocabulary			
tools	Items which can be used to create art, such as paintbrushes, rolling pins, scissors, etc.	 	
mix	To combine materials, such as different coloured paints.		
pattern	An arrangement of shapes, lines, letters, numbers, or colours that can be repeated or used again and again.		
bright	Strong colours or shiny reflections.		
dark	The opposite of light or pale, for example black is a dark colour.		
colourful	Having a lot of different colours.		
objects	A thing that can be seen or felt.		
outline	A line that shows the shape of an object.		
Key Facts		 	
Art can be made on paper, by modelling or by a persons experiences.			
Some people make art to tell other people about their thoughts or beliefs.			
Colours can be mixed to make other colours.			
We can represent items by drawing shapes then using the right colours.			
We can copy the style of an artist by using pattern.
