Pupil Premium and Pupil Premium +

Is your child eligible?



What is the Pupil Premium or

Pupil Premium +?

The Pupil Premium and Pupil Premium + is additional funding from the Government that is used to help to raise the attainment of eligible children. A school can decide how to use the funding to support the children's individual needs. This could be through the use of additional learning support for a child, staff training or wider support for a child that extends beyond the curriculum. Schools must publish details on how the pupil premium funding has been allocated, and the effect this has had on the progress and attainment of the pupils who attract the funding. These reports can be found on the school website or are available on request from the school office.

Who is eligible for Pupil Premium +?

- Children who are 'looked after' or have been 'previously looked after' by a local authority.
- Children who are subject to a special guardianship or permanent residency order.

Who may be eligible for the Pupil Premium

- Children whose parents are serving members of the armed forces
- Families who may be eligible for the benefits listed below
 - ⇒ Income Support
 - ⇒ Child Tax Credit (providing not in receipt of Working Tax Credit and do not have an annual income which exceeds £16, 190)
 - ⇒ Income based Job Seekers Allowance
 - ⇒ Employment Support Allowance
 - ⇒ Guaranteed element of state pension credit
 - ⇒ Support under part IV of the Immigration and Asylum act
