Key Vocabulary

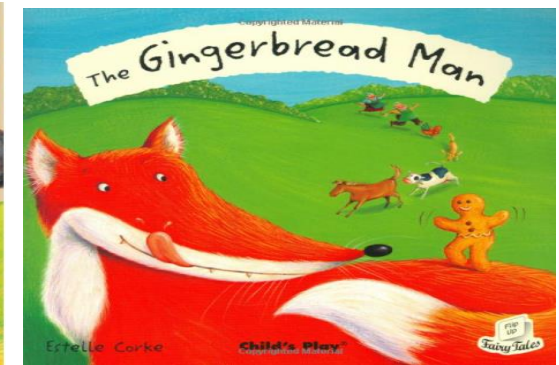
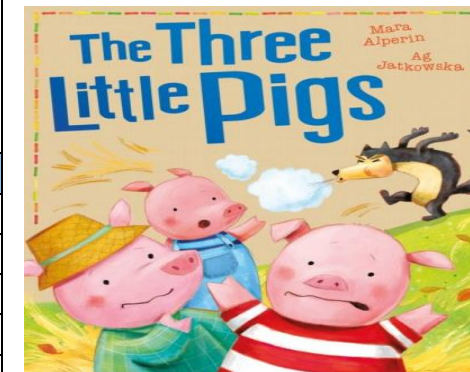
Images, icons and maps.
