Prior Learning	Concepts
<p>Recognise the phase 2 and 3 graphemes taught, using their phonic knowledge to decode words, including real and nonsense words.</p> <p>Read words containing adjacent consonants and phase 3 digraphs and trigraphs.</p> <p>Use phonic knowledge as the main route to decoding unknown words with phonemes taught so far.</p> <p>Read words and sentences accurately and fluently, re reading books to build up the confidence, fluency, understanding and enjoyment.</p>	<p>Word Reading – "Reading" is the process of looking at a series of written symbols and getting meaning from them. When we read, we use our eyes to receive written symbols (letters, punctuation marks and spaces) and we use our brain to convert them into words and sentences that communicate something to us.</p> <p>Fluency – Fluency is defined as the ability to read with speed, accuracy, and proper expression. To understand what we read, we must be able to read fluently whether we are reading aloud or silently</p>

Key Vocabulary	
Grapheme	A grapheme is a letter, or group of letters, that acts as the smallest unit in a written language.
Phoneme	A phoneme is the smallest unit of sound in speech.
Tricky Word	A tricky word is a word that cannot be sounded out easily.
Vocabulary	Vocabulary word are words that will come up in the book that will need to be known.
Sounding out	The process of decoding a word by identifying the sounds of each individual letter in the word.
Blend to read	The process of putting the individual sounds in a word together.
