I know people celebrate special times.








**Concepts**

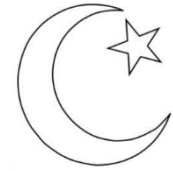
**Belonging** – Things in their right place, or a feeling of welcome.

## Key Vocabulary

<b>Religion</b>		A set of beliefs that are important to a group of people.
<b>Ceremony</b>		Important and traditional activities on a special or sacred occasion.
<b>Muslim</b>		Muslims believe in one God (Allah) and show welcome to babies at an Aqiqah ceremony.
<b>Hindu</b>		Hindus believe in one God who has many different images and names. Hindus show welcome at Raksha Bandhan.
<b>Christian</b>		Christians who believe in God and Jesus. Christians show welcome to babies at a Christening.

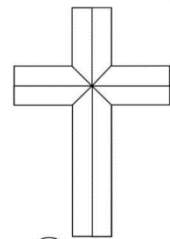
