Prior Learning

Concepts

Diversity – A belief in God or Gods and the activities linked with the particular faith, eg prayer or going to a place of worship. Some of the main traditions we study are the Muslim, Jewish, Christian, Buddhist, Sikh and Hindu.

Understanding – of key religions around the world, demonstrate empathy for those around the world

Muslim	A tradition that has Allah (God) and Muhammad as their inspiration
Jewish	A tradition based on the idea that there is one God
Tradition	A way of life
Inspirational	Ideas and actions that others want to follow, do
