

RE – The Good News / Gospel

Prior Learning

- Recall that Christians believe Jesus brings 'Good News'
- Jesus had 12 special friends, known as disciples.
- Jesus made this promise to give his disciples peace in their hearts

Concepts

Christians were feeling lonely or unloved, could turn to God for comfort

Christians love God and their neighbour by following the good news that Jesus brought

Key Vocabulary

Friendship

A friend is a person that someone likes or knows

Forgiveness

Forgiveness simply means you're **letting go of feelings of resentment and vengeance**

Peace

a state of freedom from war or conflict.

Disciple

The word gospel means "**good news,**" and gospel songs often praise God or Jesus. Many gospel songs also describe struggles and hard times.

Good News

When we believe that Jesus is God's Son and that he died and came back to life to rescue US—we get to be part of God's family forever!
